

BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MINUTES

FEBRUARY 27, 2018

At a worksession of the Orange County Board of Supervisors held on Tuesday, February 27, 2018, beginning at 2:30 p.m., in the Meeting Room of the Gordon Building, 112 West Main Street, Orange, Virginia. Present: James K. White, Chairman; James P. Crozier, Vice Chairman; R. Mark Johnson; S. Teel Goodwin; and Lee H. Frame. Also present: R. Bryan David, County Administrator; Kurt Hildebrand, Assistant County Administrator for Operations; and Alyson A. Simpson, Chief Deputy Clerk.

RE: FINAL SCHEMATIC DESIGN FOR CONSOLIDATED PUBLIC SAFETY FACILITY

Kurt Hildebrand, Assistant County Administrator for Operations, explained that Wiley|Wilson had continued its work on the schematic design plans and site layout for the Consolidated Public Safety Facility following the last discussion on November 28, 2017. He turned the presentation over to Randy Vaughan, representative of Wiley|Wilson.

Mr. Vaughan reviewed the new iteration of the proposed site layout; landscaping plan; refined building layout; proposed exterior elevations; interior designs; proposed schedule; and cost estimates.

Discussion ensued among the Board regarding: the number of public parking spaces, and whether those spaces would be adequate; overflow parking; location of the flag plaza; types of landscape species; use of exterior fencing; changes proposed at the intersection with Bloomsbury Road; seating capacity in the multi-purpose room; maximum capacity of the multi-purpose room; a change in the curvature of the dais; audio and video design; electrical back-up; conditioned spaces; electrical and mechanical systems; durability of the construction materials; cost of the proposed rotunda feature; use of ballistics material; and layout of the multi-purpose room.

Mr. Hildebrand briefly reviewed the next steps in the process, which included progressing away from schematic design and into preliminary design.

Discussion ensued among the Board regarding: presentation of preliminary designs to the Board; review of the proposed project schedule; construction length; construction oversight; clerk of the works; maintenance of the project budget; inclusion of specific language in the contract to protect the County; the current status of the project budget; and stormwater management efforts.

The Board took the information regarding the Consolidated Public Safety Facility under advisement, and there was no action taken at this time.
