



As part of its Regular Meeting scheduled for 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, September 14, 2021, the Orange County Board of Supervisors will hold a public hearing to receive comments on, and consider, the following:

REGIONAL CIGARETTE TAX ADMINISTRATION

The Board of Supervisors will consider establishing a cigarette tax pursuant to §58.1-3830 of the Code of Virginia. As part of the administration of said cigarette tax, the Board will consider adopting an ordinance to join the Blue Ridge Cigarette Tax Board for the purposes of delegating administration of the cigarette tax to said Tax Board.

EASEMENT TO RAPPAHANNOCK ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE

The Board of Supervisors will consider the conveyance of an underground service easement on County-owned property at 27531 Constitution Highway to Rappahannock Electric Cooperative, by way of Right-of-Way Easement Agreement. Said easement is necessary for Rappahannock Electric Cooperative to connect power to a nearby residence under construction.

All interested persons are invited to attend the hearing and to present their views and/or to submit written comments for the Board's consideration.
