Staff will be taught new software aimed at making the checkout process faster and more convenient for customers. Staff will also be learning about several new online resources, so they can better assist customers with the utilization of these resources. These new products can be found through the library homepage www.ocplva.org, under the research tab. The newest online resources include: a Virginia legal forms collection; a Books & Authors database that connects readers to books and Literati; and a portal that searches many research products at once. During the closure of the libraries, customers may place holds online and use the exterior book drops located near the entrance to each facility to return items.
