ORANGE COUNTY LIFTS LOCAL STATE OF EMERGENCY

Orange County, VA – Following the conclusion of the recent winter storm, Orange County officials have determined to lift the Local State of Emergency at 5:00 p.m., today, February 14, 2014.

At the height of the winter storm, there were no power outages or weather-related emergencies reported, and the Emergency Operations Center was not activated. Most areas of the County were affected by 10" to 15" of snow, as reported by the National Weather Service.
