And has spoken with the National Honor Society members and they will offer volunteers again this year for the event. Scotts Recycling emailed the contract for this year and still working on the tv collection.
- Citizens concerns – Catherine Smith attended the meeting and discussed her concerns with the roadways not being cleaned. In previous emails she requested the ability to have inmates clean the roadways. Ron, discussed that he has spoken with the county and is in the process of working out details to have inmates clean the roadways. Progress has been made.
