

Per the Code of Virginia, all dogs must be vaccinated for rabies by the time they are 4 months old. All dogs must be licensed in the locality where they live.

Orange County Fees

If your dog **is** spayed or neutered:

1 year tag: \$5.00
2 year tag: \$10.00
3 year tag: \$15.00

If your dog **is not** spayed or neutered:

1 year tag: \$10.00
2 year tag: \$20.00
3 year tag: \$30.00

Kennel Tags: (Sold yearly)

10 Dogs \$25.00
20 Dogs: \$35.00
30 Dogs: \$45.00
40 Dogs: \$50.00
50 Dogs: \$50.00

Tags may be purchased for three years depending upon the expiration date of the rabies vaccination. All dog tags expire January 31st of the year.

Although state law has required licenses for dogs since 1972, the General Assembly of 2006 and 2007 has brought changes to our licensing process. Effective July 1, 2007, area veterinarians are required to notify the Treasurer of the locality in which the vaccination occurs. If the dog owner has not purchased a dog license within 90 days of the vaccination, the local Treasurer is required to transmit an application to the owner for each dog not licensed.
